

Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS)

CSCS is the leading skills certification scheme within the UK construction industry. Most major contractors and homebuilders require workers on their sites to hold a valid CSCS card. This card proves an individual's identity and shows employers that they have the required training, qualifications and experience for working on a construction site.

Delegates learn all aspects of working safely in a construction environment and then sit a 50 question, multi choice test. A score report is available immediately which means successful candidates can start working on a construction site straightaway.

- SQA Certificate Level 1
- Health & Safety in a Construction Environment (Green Card - Labourer)
- Health & Safety in a Construction Environment (Blue Card - Skilled Worker). This is for time served trades people who have a SVQ Level 2 or above.
